Support Service

Domestic abuse is any incident of threatening behaviour, violence and abuse (psychological, physical, sexual, financial or emotional) between adults who are, or have been, intimate partners. Many women in this situation are isolated and may never have spoken to anyone about their experiences.

As you look at this list you may see some things you identify with.

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My Partner:

- Puts me down
- Becomes surly and angry if I tell him he's drinking too much
- Makes me perform sex acts I do not like or enjoy whether I want to or not
- Is jealous and suspicious of my family and friends
- Tells me I am ugly and unattractive
- Tells me I can't manage without him
- Treats me like his personal servant
- Humiliates me in front of family, friends and other people
- Becomes very angry if I disagree with his point of view
- Punches doors or walls, throws objects at me and breaks my things
- Often keeps me short of money
- Acts like a bully towards me, frightens me and says I'm stupid
- Demands that I stay at home to look after the children
- Beats me so badly that I should go to the doctor – but he won't let me
- Is not kind and screams and yells at me
- Is like Jekyll and Hyde – he's very charming to others but not to me or the children
- Has no respect for my feelings
- Threatens to kill me if I say I'm leaving
- Does not think I should work or study
- Says he's sorry and promises to change but never does



**If you answer yes to any of these statements it is likely that you are already in a harmful relationship.**

The Women's Safety Worker is there to help you to be safe while your (ex)partner is attending the programme.

Your worker will understand and be supportive of your situation.
